RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Cost sharing for APHIS Coordinator from tribal departments)

WHEREAS, Al Wyatt, the APHIS (Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service) Coordinator, has come before the Tribal Council this date to update them on his program; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Wyatt has informed Council of serious health hazards associated with animals such as Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever and of his willingness to assist in combating animal diseases; and

WHEREAS, unfortunately funding for his program will soon cease.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that the following programs provide cost-sharing funding for Mr. Wyatt: Division of Health, Planning & Resources Conservation Department, Land Operation, Wildlife & Outdoor Recreation Division, Police Department and CDC until such time as grant is received.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 6, 2005</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
