


**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION
(Approving the Agreement between Lawrence Berger and the
White Mountain Apache Tribe)**

- WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution No. 09-2003-228, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council approved the Whiteriver Police Department request to submit a grant application to the Center for Disease Control (CDC) for the purpose of establishing a full-time traffic safety program for a four (4) year grant period; and
- WHEREAS**, the grant entitled, "Evidence-based motor vehicle crash prevention strategies" was approved by the CDC; and
- WHEREAS**, pursuant to said grant, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is required to review data and procedures and prepare an evaluation plan of it's crash prevention strategies and implement better crash prevention strategies; and
- WHEREAS**, it will benefit the White Mountain Apache Tribe to contract with Lawrence Berger, MD, MPH to provide consulting services to assist it in meeting the requirements of the CDC grant.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. It hereby approves an agreement between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Lawrence Berger for purposes of meeting the requirements of the CDC grant, "Evidence-based motor vehicle crash prevention strategies"; and
2. The Agreement between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Mr. Berger shall not exceed \$9,300.00, inclusive of all expenses; and
3. The Tribal Chairman, and in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute any and all documents necessary to implement the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on MARCH 7, 2005 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (j), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
