RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving the White Mountain Apache Tribe Financial Management Policy and Procedures Manual)

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is aware that the Central Tribe's financial policies and procedures are based upon historical practice and had a draft in written form approved through the Tribal Council on December 05, 2002; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council acknowledges that 25 CFR Part 900.45 (a)-(g) requires that a financial management system be in place and specifically addresses financial reporting, accounting records, internal and budgetary controls, source documentation, allowable costs and cash management; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further acknowledges that if these regulatory requirements by the CFR are not met, future grant funding will be jeopardized; and
- WHEREAS, the single audits prepared by the Tribe's Independent Auditor (REDW) has reported the lack of a financial policies and procedures manual as a finding for the past several years; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, along with the Treasurer and Controller, recognize that portions of the proposed policy may require revision after the policy operates for an interim period of 60 days; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council desires to give effect to the intent of the policies while reserving time to hear concerns from affected employees on how to improve the policy in areas that may require changes.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the White Mountain Apache Tribe Financial Management Policy and Procedures Manual to be used and carried out as intended.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Treasurer and Tribal Controller to bring needed changes as required.
