RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving Michael Minjarez' proposal to utilize juniper, pine and oak logs)

WHEREAS, tribal member Michael Minjarez has come before the Tribal Council this date with a proposal to utilize juniper, pine and oak logs; and

WHEREAS, these logs will be used for residential and business purposes; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Minjarez also requests permission to haul these logs off the reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby:

- 1. Grants approval for Michael Minjarez to use juniper, pine and oak logs for purposes stated.
- 2. Directs Tribal Forest Manager, Paul Declay, Jr., to help coordinate this venture and to follow up on other similar present and future requests to prevent problems.

The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
