**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Directing all Tribal Government Programs and Enterprises to utilize Apache owned Pesticide Treatment Services)

WHEREAS, Fort Apache Pesticide Company ("FAPCO") made a presentation to the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, FAPCO is certified and licensed by the State of Arizona to provide pesticide treatment services; and


WHEREAS, FAPCO is owned and operated by members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is in the best interests of the Tribe that all government programs and enterprises of the Tribe buy goods and services provided by businesses owned and operated by members of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all tribal government programs and enterprises are hereby directed to utilize pesticide treatment services provided by businesses owned and operated by members of the Tribe that are certified and licensed by the State of Arizona to provide such services.

The foregoing resolution was on July 6, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
