WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Directing Council Member Phoebe Nez to research records related to past Miss White Mountain Apache queens)**

**WHEREAS**, tribal member Joanne Kane has come before the Tribal Council this date to share her concern; and


**WHEREAS**, Ms. Kane has informed the Tribal Council that she was the first Miss White Mountain Apache Queen in 1955 at the age of 13, although Ms. Evelyn (Walker) Kinney is recognized as such; and

**WHEREAS**, at that time there was no Queen Committee, nor any records that she is aware of; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Kane requests that this matter be reviewed and verified by the tribe.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby assigns Council Member Phoebe Nez to research Ms. Joanne Kane's request.

The foregoing resolution was on July 6, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
