

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving Expenditure Totaling \$6,500.00 for Cibecue July 4th Festivities from Rodeo-Chediski Fire Complex Donation Fund)

- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes that each year it celebrates the 4th of July through community events which include various sports tournaments, concerts, dances, parades, royalty contests, gospel concerts and a fireworks spectacular; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to continue this tradition and wants to assist the community of Cibecue by holding festivities where the Rodeo-Chediski had the greatest impact; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is aware that the community of Cibecue, through its President Lorin Henry, has been planning several activities to take advantage of this holiday, and the Council has received written reports on such plans and finds them suitable to celebrate the 4th of July, as attached and incorporated by this reference; and
- WHEREAS, a request was made by Council Member Jacob Henry to expend a total of \$6,500.00 for expenses related to the Begay Brothers who handled the stock (\$2,200), Country Image (\$530), Darren Francis who handled stock for the Junior Rodeo (\$1,500), EMS (\$500) and other miscellaneous costs (\$1,770).
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Treasurer to disburse a total of \$6,500.00 from the Rodeo-Chediski Fire Complex Donation Fund for the Cibecue 4th of July festivities, according to the budget as attached and incorporated by this reference.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 25, 2005</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (j), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
