

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Requesting a P.L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for an Environmental Assessment for the Safety of Dams Project)

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the governing body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the U. S. Department of Interior Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA") has offered the White Mountain Apache Tribe's Planning Department \$50,000.00 to complete an Environmental Assessment for Horseshoe Dam as part of the Safety of Dams Project; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has, under P.L. 96-638 (25 U.S.C. § 450 et seq.) contracting principles, previously and successfully contracted from the Bureau of Indian Affairs to perform the duties required of the Safety of Dams Project; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe's Planning Office, together with Wildlife and Outdoor, Hydrology, Watershed, Environmental Planning and Historic Preservation Office, intends to use the funds as needed for personnel, equipment, materials and supplies, travel and subcontractors required for an environmental assessment; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that to augment the management practices it has begun, a contract with the BIA for the Environmental Assessment for the Safety of Dams Project under 638 contracting principles is in the best interests of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

- 1. A contract pursuant to P.L. 93-638 (25 U.S.C. § 450 et seq.) is hereby requested from the U.S. Department of Interior for the purposes of undertaking an environmental assessment for the Safety of Dams Project.
- 2. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents and agreements necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
