(Approval to grant tribal relinquishment request of Erick Rudell Walker)

- WHEREAS, Tribal member Erick Rudell Walker, date of birth: 08/01/1972, son of Rudy Walker and Cora Nelson, has requested that his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that he may become eligible for enrollment with the San Carlos Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the necessary document of relinquishment of head rights was signed by Erick Rudell Walker in the presence of a Notary Public on the 22nd day of April, 2005 and is attached hereto; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Enrollment Committee approved this relinquishment request at their meeting on August 30, 2005.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the tribal relinquishment request of Erick Rudell Walker. and his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is relinquished, along with any and all privileges accorded members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe such as, but not limited to hunting, fishing, and recreational privileges upon the White Mountain Apache Indian Reservation.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Office of Vital Records to remove Erick Rudell Walker from the membership rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 14, 2005</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article II, Section 2 and Article IV, Section 1of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
