

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approval to grant non-member burial on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that Abigail (Tortice) Wilson, is requesting Tribal Council permission for her daughter, Juanita (Wilson) Joe, to be buried in McNary, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, Juanita (Wilson) Joe was not a member of the Tribe; however, she has lived in McNary, Arizona for many years; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the request by Abigail (Tortice) Wilson and family members of the late Juanita (Wilson) Joe that she be buried in McNary, Arizona on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on October 6, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
