**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Directing Chief Reuben Kessay Submit and Present WMAPD Operating Budget and
Capital Request on November 9, 2005)**

WHEREAS, Reuben Kessay, Chief of the White Mountain Apache Police Department has submitted a capital budget request of \$216,000.00 to the Budget Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee did present the WMAPD capital budget to the Tribal Council; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has concerns regarding the WMAPD request and the overall operating budget, yet Chief Kessay was on travel status and unavailable; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the request has been made twice before, and leadership on the funding of WMAPD is essential to morale and effective operations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that Chief Reuben Kessay is hereby directed to submit and present the WMAPD Operating Budget and Capital Request to the Tribal Council in person at its next regularly scheduled meeting on November 9, 2005.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event that Chief Kessay is unavailable on November 9, 2005, he either resign or be terminated by the Chairman.

The foregoing resolution was on October 24, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
