**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Directing Housing Authority to replace Nettie DeClay's stove)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the White Mountain Apache Constitution, Article IV, Sections 1(a), *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to "represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe, and to make decisions not inconsistent with or contrary to the Constitution;" and


**WHEREAS**, Council Member Mariddie Craig has informed the Tribal Council this date that an elder tribal member Nettie DeClay is having problems with her stove; and


**WHEREAS**, Council Member Craig has recommended that Housing Authority replace Ms. DeClay's stove.

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that replacement of Ms. DeClay's stove is warranted.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Housing Authority to replace Nettie DeClay's stove for health and safety purposes.

The foregoing resolution was on October 25, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
