## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

## (Recommending Allen Anspach for the Position of Bureau of Indian Affairs Western Regional Director)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1(a) and 1(b) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe, negotiate, make and perform contracts, and manage all economic affairs and enterprises; and
- WHEREAS, W. Patrick Ragsdale, the Director of the U.S. Department of Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs, has informed the Tribal Council of four candidates for the position of BIA Western Regional Director; and
- WHEREAS, the candidates are Allen Anspach, Bryan Bowker, Betty Tippeconnic, and John E. White, their resumes were distributed to members of the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, Allen Anspach is the Superintendent of the BIA Fort Apache Agency; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after careful review and consideration of the candidates, finds that Allen Anspach is best qualified for the position, and his selection is in the best interests of the Tribe.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that it hereby recommends Allen Anspach as the best qualified person for the position of Director, U.S. Department of Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>NOVEMBER 16, 2005</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>FIVE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (c), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
