

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Granting ownership and title of the Tribal Rental Housing Unit #122 to tribal member Anna L. Goseyun)

WHEREAS, Tribal member Anna Goseyun has requested that the Tribal Council assign her the Tribal housing unit described as Tribal Rental Housing Unit #122; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Goseyun has lived in this unit since 1986; and

WHEREAS, many maintenance repairs/improvements on the unit has not been addressed by Tribal Maintenance but by Ms. Goseyun; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Goseyun is requesting ownership of Tribal Rental Housing #122.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

- 1. Ownership and title of the Tribal Rental Housing Unit #122 at 122 W. Oak Street is hereby granted to Tribal member Anna Goseyun.
- 2. As a condition of this transfer of ownership, Ms. Goseyun shall be responsible for securing a land assignment or residential lease for Tribal Rental Housing Unit #122, and Ms. Goseyun is prohibited from selling said home for a period of three years from the date of this Resolution.
- 3. The Legal Department is hereby directed to prepare transfer of ownership documents which relieves the Tribe of any further responsibility for maintenance and repair of said home.
- 4. The Tribal Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, and any other officials designated by the Chairman, are hereby authorized to sign any documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 7, 2005</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
