**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Authorizing Transfer of a Tribal Vehicle to the Canyon Day Livestock Association)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Sections 1(a) and 1(h) of the White Mountain Apache Constitution, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe, and to regulate the uses and disposition of tribal property; and


WHEREAS, Chairman Massey informed the Tribal Council that per Don Antonio, a member of the Canyon Day Livestock Association, this association has a need for a truck; and;

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that a transfer of the Truck's title from the Tribe to the Association is in the best interests of the Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council:

1. Transfer of the Tribe's truck title, license G-319AW, VIN#2FTHF26H3TCA18404, to the Canyon Day Livestock Association is hereby authorized.
2. The Canyon Day Livestock Association is hereby directed to assume title and insurance to the Truck.
3. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on December 7, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
