

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving financial assistance and the use of vehicle and credit card to Fairrison Riley to travel to New Orleans)

WHEREAS, earlier this month, some members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe traveled to New Orleans to assist in the hurricane relief effort and/or to obtain employment; and

WHEREAS, it was reported to the Tribal Council that two members are very ill and wish to return; and

WHEREAS, it was recommended that tribal member Fairrison Riley, who was a driver to and from New Orleans, pick up the two individuals; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that reimbursement of Mr. Riley's expenses is proper and in the best interests of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes \$500.00, a tribal vehicle and gas credit card to Fairrison Riley in order to travel to New Orleans to return the two sick tribal members.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>DECEMBER 8, 2005</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(a), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
