

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Directing the Whiteriver Police Department to pay all funeral and burial expenses for Myron Gooday)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is empowered to act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, White Mountain Apache Tribal Police Officers were asked to respond to an incident at the Gooday household that involved one Myron Gooday; and

WHEREAS, the police intervention resulted in the death of Myron Gooday; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was approached by the family of the late Myron Gooday this day and requested that the Whiteriver Police Department pay for all funeral and burial expenses for Myron Gooday.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Whiteriver Police Department to pay all funeral and burial expenses for the late Myron Gooday.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 27, 2005</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
