

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Appointing Ms. Mary Barraza as TERO Commissioner)

- WHEREAS, Mr. Alvino Hawkins, Sr., Director of Tribal Employment Rights Office has notified the Tribal Council this day that Gerald Alsenay has resigned as TERO/TAP Commissioner; and
- WHEREAS, the tribal TERO/TAP Director recommended to the commissioners during the meeting on Tuesday, December 13, 2005, that Ms. Mary Barraza replaced Mr. Gerald Alsenay; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in the Director's recommendation, and finds the appointment of Ms. Mary Barraza in the best interest of the Tribe.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Ms. Mary Barraza is hereby appointed to the position of TERO Commissioner, subject to a background check.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 5, 2006</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (q), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
