

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Rescinding Resolution No. 01-2006-05 and directing the White Mountain Apache Tribe's Police Department to temporarily move Officers Daley, Cole and Dale out of Cibecue)

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is empowered to act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe's Police Department responded to a call in Cibecue whereby their intervention resulted in the death of Myron Gooday; and
- WHEREAS, subsequent to the death of Mr. Gooday, Police Officers Matt Daley, Maury Cole and Bernard Dale were placed on administrative leave with pay pending the outcome of an investigation being conducted by the FBI; and
- WHEREAS, upon hearing this, the Gooday family approached the Tribal Council and requested that the three Police Officers be placed on administrative leave without pay and to temporarily move the officers out of Cibecue pending the results of the investigation; and
- WHEREAS, by Tribal Council Resolution No. 01-2006-05, the Tribal Council directed the Police Department to place Officers Daley, Cole and Dale on Administrative Leave without pay and to temporarily move the officers out of Cibecue pending the results of the investigation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reconsidered Resolution No. 01-2006-05 and believes that the Police Officers should be placed on Administrative Leave with pay; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council still believes that in the interest of maintaining peace and safety in Cibecue, the Police Officers should be temporarily removed from Cibecue pending the results of the investigation, as several threats have been made against the Police Officers.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby rescinds Resolution No. 01-2006-05 and directs the Police Department to temporarily move Police Officers Daley, Cole and Dale, and/or their families, out of Cibecue if required for their safety, pending the results of the FBI investigation, and otherwise provide such other assistance as may be available.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 12, 2006</u>, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
