

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Directing Tribal Treasurer, Controller and Finance Committee to seek funds for Election Precinct Buildings)

WHEREAS, Election Commission Vice-Chairperson Delbin Endfield this day did report to the Tribal Council on status of precinct buildings; and

WHEREAS, the main problems presented were faced by the Seven Mile, East Fork and Canyon Day Community Buildings and the Memorial Hall; and

WHEREAS, these buildings lack heat and/or bathroom facilities for the precinct workers; and

WHEREAS, the Election Commission does not have the budget to address the problems noted.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Treasurer, Controller and the Finance Committee to identify funds for repairs as needed for the above referenced buildings.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that these repairs be completed before the Tribe's General Election on April 5, 2006, subject to the availability of funds and required resources.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 9, 2006</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (e), (h), (i), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
