**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Directing the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority to Reverse the Eviction of Amy Beatty and Provide Restitution)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Amy Beatty was evicted by the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority from Life Savers, Housing Trailer No. 13 and she subsequently appealed to the Housing Board, which was denied; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Beatty this day appealed to the Tribal Council claiming that her eviction and appeal were unfair and without due process; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Beatty has appealed her eviction to the Tribal Council, requesting that she be returned to her home and that she be provided restitution for her losses; and

WHEREAS, while Ms. Beatty presented letters she submitted to the Housing Authority and the Housing Board; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that an eviction of Ms. Beatty was done unfairly.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe Tribal Council that:

1. The eviction of Amy Beatty by the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority is hereby reversed.
2. The WMAHA is hereby directed to return Ms. Beatty to her home and provide her restitution of reasonable expenses or losses she may have incurred due to her eviction within five working days of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 8, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (e), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
