**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Arizona for Anti-Meth Initiative)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, methamphetamine abuse and addiction has become prevalent among members of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has proposed an intergovernmental agreement with the Tribe for the purposes of developing strategic prevention and activities related to the impact and consequences of methamphetamine use and production in local communities; and

WHEREAS, under the proposed IGA, the State would reimburse the Tribe up to \$20,000 for the following:

- (1) sending a team of at least five members of the Tribe to the Arizona Methamphetamine Conference;
- (2) hire a methamphetamine coordinator; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the IGA would greatly assist in fighting methamphetamine abuse, addiction and production and is in the best interests of the Tribe.


BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that:

1. The proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the State and the Tribe for the purposes described herein is hereby approved.
2. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
3. The Tribe's Division of Health Programs is hereby authorized to submit expenses related to the proposed IGA according to the terms expressed therein, subject to available funds.

The foregoing resolution was on March 9, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
