**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Rescinding Resolution No. 03-2006-65 Regarding Jerlynda Sanchez

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Council did consider and passed Resolution No. 03-2006-65; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Gaming Commission and the Tribal Gaming Office did this day present certain information, documents and video that was not included in Ms. Sanchez's presentation to the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, from said information it appears that the investigation of the transaction leading to the revocation of Ms. Sanchez gaming license, namely the handling of a certain void payout ticket is not complete; and

WHEREAS, based upon the information presented, Ms. Sanchez cannot be reinstated until such time as the investigation is complete; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Tribe and its gaming operation that Resolution No. 03-2006-65 be rescinded to the extent that Ms. Sanchez not be reinstated until such time as the investigation is complete

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. Resolution No. 03-2006-65 is hereby rescinded.
2. The Gaming Operation management and the Tribal Gaming Office, are hereby directed to investigate the handling of the subject ticket, and provide recommendations in writing to the Tribal Council accordingly within thirty (30) days from the date of this Resolution.
3. The Tribal Council hereby recommends to the Gaming Operation management that Ms. Sanchez remain on administrative leave for thirty days from the date of this Resolution with pay, and that the investigation should be completed within the same period.

The foregoing resolution was on March 16, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
