**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Granting ownership and title of Tribal Rental Housing Units #30, 12, 19, 4, and 11, to tribal members; Walker Truax, Vaneysa Johnson, Lucinda Daley, Freddie Dazen, Sr. and Shelly Alsenay)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, Tribal members, Walker Truax, Vaneysa Johnson, Lucinda Daley, Freddie Dazen, Sr. and Shelly Alsenay, have requested that the Tribal Council assign the Tribal Housing units described as Tribal Rental Housing units #30, 12, 19, 4 and 11; and

**WHEREAS**, these units are originally occupied by the above mentioned Tribal members; and

**WHEREAS**, these homes require many maintenance repairs/improvement; and


**WHEREAS**, Walker Truax, Vaneysa Johnson, Lucinda Daley, Freddie Dazen, Sr. and Shelly Alsenay are requesting ownership of Tribal Rental Housing Units #30, 12, 19, 4 and 11.


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that:

1. Ownership and title of the Tribal Rental Housing Units #30, 12, 19, 4 and 11 are hereby granted to tribal members, Walker Truax, Vaneysa Johnson, Lucinda Daley, Freddie Dazen, Sr. and Shelly Alsenay.
2. As a condition of this transfer of ownership, Walker Truax, Vaneysa Johnson, Lucinda Daley, Freddie Dazen, Sr. and Shelly Alsenay shall be responsible for securing a land assignment or residential lease for Tribal Rental Housing units #30, 12, 19, 4 and 11, and Tribal members are prohibited from selling said homes for a period of three years from the date of this Resolution and selling of the housing units will require council approval.
3. The Legal Department is hereby directed to prepare transfer of ownership documents which relieves the Tribe of any further responsibility for maintenance and repairs of the said home.
4. The Tribal Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, and any officials designated by the Chairman, are hereby authorized to sign any documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

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The foregoing resolution was on April 13, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
