(Approving the expenditure of \$2,500.00 for the "Apache Pride" Youth Conference 2006)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, inter alia, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Eileen Hill, Miss Indian Arizona and Cathy Garcia requested \$2,500.00 financial assistance from the Tribe for the "Apache Pride" Youth Conference scheduled on April 26, 2006, to be held at Hon-Dah Resort Casino; and

WHEREAS, this amount requested will cover expenses for guest speakers who will provide education to our Apache youth.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that it approves the expenditure of \$2,500.00 from the Tribal Contributions account for the "Apache Pride" Youth Conference on April 26, 2006, to be utilized to cover the expenses for guest speakers.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 13, 2006</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
