**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Termination of Earl Pettit from his position as Superintendent with the Whiteriver Unified School District #20)


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received numerous complaints about Superintendent Pettit that relate to his performance, professionalism and treatment of tribal children, school staff and teaches in a negative light; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes that it is in the best interests of the Tribe to terminate and remove Superintendent Pettit from his position and any other future position on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, effective today, April 19, 2006.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache that it hereby terminates and removes Earl Pettit from his position as Superintendent of the Whiteriver Unified School District #20 and any other future position on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, effective today, April 19, 2006.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for, ZERO against and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
