

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving Pay Back of Victor Walker's Annual Leave)

- **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Victor Walker did present an appeal to the Tribal Council this day for payment of accrued annual leave; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Walker did work for Apache Aerospace, and was terminated, but did not receive his accrued annual leave; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Mr. Walker should have his accrued annual leave paid back to him.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that payment of accrued annual leave for Victor Walker is hereby authorized, subject to a review of his personnel records and applicable personnel policies and procedures of that time by the Personnel Office and the maximum annual leave allowable.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 12, 2006</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for, <u>THREE</u> against and <u>ONE</u> abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
