**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving lumber and other repairs for Erma Garcia's home)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, tribal member Erma Garcia informed Council that her home experienced some damage as a result of the Rainbow Fire; and

WHEREAS, others were provided resources to repair homes damaged by the Rainbow Fire, but not Ms. Garcia's family; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Garcia requests lumber to repair home, as well as to have her windows replaced; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Garcia further requests that Housing Authority replace her stove and refrigerator.


BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that:

1. Fort Apache Timber Company is hereby requested to provide a bundle of lumber to repair damage to home.
2. Tribal Maintenance Department is hereby directed to repair and/or replace windows that were damaged.
3. Housing Authority is hereby requested to replace stove and refrigerator.

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
