**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving a business license for Marian Beatty)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council, convening on May 16, 2006 for Tribal member requests, received Marian Beatty's request for a small business license to sell products and use of the building known as the old Day Care Center; and


WHEREAS, Ms. Beatty's business will sell Pendleton products and other necessities; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the need to develop small business enterprises within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation owned and operated by members of the Tribe and finds that Ms. Beatty's request to be in the best interest of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Treasurer to issue a business license to Marian Beatty effective this day, for the purpose of operating a small business that will service residents of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
