**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


(Directing Land Operations to Cut a Road for Georgianna Truax))

- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, inter alia, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** Georgianna Truax did this day come before the Tribal Council seeking assistance with a road near her residence in Whiskey Flat, as well as clearing land and placement of a bridge over upper Carrizo stream so that she may gain access to her corn plot; and
- WHEREAS,** Land Operations has equipment near the area that may provide such assistance; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds that Land Operations should provide assistance to Ms. Truax.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribe's Land Operations Office is hereby directed to provide Georgianna Truax with cutting a road to her residence in Whiskey Flat, clearing land near the residence and placement of a bridge over the upper Carrizo stream so that she may gain access to her corn plot.

The foregoing resolution was on March 17, 2006 adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Sections 1(a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
