**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Authorizing the Transfer of Certain Office Fixtures to Former Chairman Massey and Vice-Chairman Enfield)


- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, inter alia, the Tribal Council has the authority to respect the Tribe and act in all matters that concerns the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** Chairman Dallas Massey and Vice-Chairman Endfield have a distinguished record of service on the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Council Members named herein were provided certain office fixtures to fulfill their duties; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds that in recognition of the outgoing Council Members service to the Tribe their office fixtures and computers should be provided to them as gifts; and
- WHEREAS,** prior Resolution Nos. 06-2002-119, 04-2000-124 and 86-103 had previously authorized irrevocable conveyances of vehicles as gifts to previous Council members in honor and recognition of their service.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. The office fixtures from the offices of the Chair and Vice-Chair of the Tribal Council are hereby provided to Dallas Massey, Sr. and Frank Johnny Endfield as gifts in recognition of their service to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
2. Mr. Massey and Mr. Endfield are directed to return the hard drives of the computers provided under this Resolution or a copy thereof.
3. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuated to intent of the Resoulution, subject to review by the Legal Department.

The foregoing resolution was on March 17, 2006 adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Sections 1(a), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
