



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Approving Renewal of Expired Lease for Althea Gloshey)**

**WHEREAS**, Althea (Hastings) Gloshey has an expired lease for her residential home in the area of Canyon Day; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Gloshey has applied for a loan from Wells Fargo Bank of Arizona to construct a new home on the same site; and

**WHEREAS**, for the purposes of mortgaging the leasehold improvements, Wells Fargo requires a residential lease in the name of Althea (Hastings) Gloshey, the proposed borrower; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council has no objection to the use of this land by Ms. Gloshey; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council has no objection to the lessors mortgaging the lease hold improvements to Wells Fargo Bank.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache that:

1. A lease between the Tribe and Althea (Hastings) Gloshey is hereby approved for a period of twenty-five (25) years automatically renewable for an additional term of twenty-five (25) years.
2. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute the lease and any and all documents related to the mortgage of leasehold improvements between Wells Fargo Bank and Ms. Gloshey, subject to review by the Realty Office and the Legal Department as may be required.

The foregoing resolution was on May 24, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (m), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
