

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Authorizing Verna Lee Nachu to be added to the list of Settlement Payment for Wrongfully Terminated Employees)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was informed that Verna Lee Nachu, a member of the Tribe, was wrongfully terminated from her position with the Tribe in 1998; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Nachu claims that her termination was politically motivated and thus wrongful; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that this member was wrongfully terminated and that the Tribe should settle her claim in the amount of \$13,184.00.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Verna Lee Nachu be added to the list of employees wrongfully terminated and for settlement of her claims in the amount of \$13,184.00.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 7, 2006</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>THREE</u> for and <u>TWO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
