**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Directing Various Programs to Consider Michelle Yazzie for Summer Employment)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Michelle Yazzie, a member of the Tribe, did this day come before the Tribal Council concerning her difficulty in obtaining part-time employment as a summer youth worker in the area of criminal justice; and


WHEREAS, Ms. Yazzie is a graduate of Northland Pioneer College with an Associate of Arts degree in Criminal Justice and plans to attend Northern Arizona University in the fall to pursue her Bachelor of Arts degree; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Ms. Yazzie is suitable for employment with either the Court, the White Mountain Apache Police Department, the Prosecutors Office or the Legal Department, and these programs should find a position for her.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Office of Personnel shall coordinate with the White Mountain Apache Tribe Court, the White Mountain Apache Police Department, the Prosecutors Office and the Legal Department to find suitable part-time employment for Ms. Yazzie for the remainder of the summer, 2006.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
