**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving Publication of Manuscripts by Johns Hopkins University)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council supports carefully designed research projects to evaluate health problems which exist in the population and to develop appropriate interventions which seek to decrease or alleviate these problems; and

WHEREAS, Johns Hopkins has this day requested permission to present study findings in the medical journal "Journal of Infectious Diseases"; and


WHEREAS, the two manuscripts submitted for publication approval include 1) "*Anti-capsular serum antibody concentration against pneumococcal colonization induced by 7-valent conjugate pneumococcal vaccine (PnCRM7) and 2) "Predictors of conjugate pneumococcal vaccine immunogenicity among infants and toddlers in the American Indian PnCRM7 Efficacy Trial"*"; and


WHEREAS, Johns Hopkins staff have promised that no personal identifiers are indicated or referenced and all information contained in the manuscript is submitted for the purpose of developing strategies designed to intervene and diminish the problems associated with pneumococcal disease; and

WHEREAS, Tribal Council finds that publication of the two proposed manuscripts are in the best interest of the health care of members of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves that the manuscripts be published as identified herein.

The foregoing resolution was on June 8, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
