**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Approving the MOA between the ITCA and the Tribe's Apache Diabetes Wellness Center)**

**WHEREAS,** the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe empowers the Tribal Council to act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc. and the White Mountain Apache Tribe's Apache Diabetes Wellness Center have been responsible for the delivery of vital health services to the Native American population for many years; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribe's Apache Diabetes Wellness Center and the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc. would like to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to evaluate five (5) years of health screening information to interpret results so that disease trends and common health and wellness related issues can be identified; and

**WHEREAS,** the results then can be used to design interventions programs to improve the health of the White Mountain Apache Tribal members; and

**WHEREAS,** the work to be performed shall be funded by the grant awarded by the Special Diabetes Program for Indians, Indian Health Service, to the Apache Diabetes Wellness Center grant ; and

**WHEREAS,** the Special Diabetes Program has authorized \$100,000 to be utilized by the Apache Diabetes Wellness Center to perform the work specified in the MOA; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribe's Division of Health, Health Board, has approved the MOA and recommend its approval by the Tribal Council; and

**WHEREAS,** the MOA (re; Screening Project) between the ITCA, Inc. and the WMAT is considered necessary and is in the best interests of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe's Apache Diabetes Wellness Center that it hereby approves the MOA between the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc. and the White Mountain the Apache Diabetes Wellness Center Screening Project, and authorizes the Tribal Chairman or Tribal Vice-Chairwoman to negotiate and execute the MOA
