**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving the waiver of TERO fees and TERO permit for Four Mountain Construction Company)

WHEREAS, Mr. Keith and Joyce Yazzie have received Navajo Nation Relocation Funds to build a house for their family at HonDah home site lots 101 and 102; and

WHEREAS, the Yazzie family has hired Four Mountain Construction Company of Tuba City, Arizona, owned by Ray Tallsalt, a member of the Navajo Nation and licensed as a contractor with the state of Arizona; and


WHEREAS, the Yazzie family has requested that the Tribe waive the applicable TERO fees to be paid by Four Mountain Construction Company and the White Mountain Apache Tribe's TERO office has agreed to waive the 5% TERO fee of \$6,100 and the \$2,000 permit fee so that the Yazzie family can use the full amount of their Navajo Nation Relocation Funds to construct their home; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it to be in the best interests of the Tribe to waive the TERO fees.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the waiver of the 5% TERO fee of \$6,100 and \$2,000 permit fee for the Four Mountain Construction Company to build the Yazzie home at HonDah home site lots 101 and 102.

The foregoing resolution was on June 8, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
