**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION  
(Authorizing Non-Tribal Member Leroy Rogers to be buried at the Whiteriver  
Cemetery)**

**WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and**

**WHEREAS, Leroy Rogers passed away on June 21, 2006 and he is the nephew of Jones Adley, Neva Adley and Mayhome Rolland, he resided at Dark Shadows House #158 with his sister Vivian Anaya and Family for more than 20 years as a recognized member of the community; and**


**WHEREAS, the Rogers' Family is requesting financial assistance for the wake and burial; and**

**WHEREAS, the family requests that Mr. Rogers be buried next to the late Nettie Adley at the Whiteriver Cemetery in Whiteriver, Arizona on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.**

**WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that providing such assistance and allowing the burial of Mr. Rogers on the Reservation is consistent with the Apache culture and tradition.**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Leroy Rogers to be buried in the Whiteriver Cemetery and further authorizes financial assistance for the wake and burial in the amount of \$500.00.

The foregoing resolution was on June 22, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
