

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Requesting the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority Utilize Mutual Aid Assistance Funds for Rehabilitation of Housing in the Cedar Creek and Rainbow City Communities)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Jerold Altaha, a member of the Cedar Creek Community, did this day present concerns regarding the state of housing managed by the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority ("WMAHA"); and

WHEREAS, a number of such housing units are dilapidated and in serious need of repairs; and

WHEREAS, the same dire situation exists for housing in the Rainbow City community; and

WHEREAS, Mutual Aid Assistance provided by the U.S. Housing and Urban Development Department may be a source of funds to address the housing needs of the Cedar Creek and Rainbow City communities; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the housing situation in Cedar Creek and Rainbow City should be addressed by the WMAHA.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the WMAHA determine whether Mutual Aid Assistance can address the housing situation in Cedar Creek and Rainbow City, and report to the Tribal Council at its next regularly scheduled meeting as to how to address the housing needs of these communities.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 12, 2006</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
