



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Approving position transfers for Steve Dude and Bernard Josay from L.A.M.P to the Tribe)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, tribal members Steve Dude and Bernard Josay informed the Tribal Council this day that they are currently employed with the L.A.M.P. program; and

**WHEREAS**, the L.A.M.P. program offers limited employment hours; and


**WHEREAS**, Mr. Dude and Mr. Josay request employment placement within the Tribe's Janitorial Services Department, for grounds keeping and other like services; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds: (1) that Mr. Dude and Mr. Josay are suitable for employment within the Janitorial Services Department, given their past experiences at the L.A.M.P. program; (2) that they should be paid at the rate they currently receive from the L.A.M.P. program; (3) that the budget for the Department should be increased accordingly, subject to available funds.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. The employment of Steve Dude and Bernard Josay with the Tribe in the Janitorial Services Department is hereby approved and effective as of the date of this Resolution.
2. The budget for the Janitorial Services Department should be increased to accommodate the employment of Mr. Dude and Mr. Josay, who shall be paid at the rate they currently receive from the L.A.M.P. program, subject to available funds.
3. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
