**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving the cancellation of home foreclosure decision for Isalee Tahona)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and


WHEREAS, tribal member Isalee Tahona did this day informed the Tribal Council of events which lead to the foreclosure of her home mortgage by and through the Tribe's Revolving Credit Program; and


WHEREAS, Ms. Tahona has requested that the foreclosure be suspended and promises to make all full home payments.

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that suspension of the foreclosure is in the best interests of Ms. Tahona so that she may become current on her payments and debt to the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Credit Committee is hereby directed to cancel the foreclosure of Ms. Isalee Tahona's mortgage and to have Ms. Tahona's home returned to her, subject to Ms. Tahona paying all outstanding payments owned to the Tribe's Revolving Credit Program.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
