

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving travel for Chaghache' Day Care staff)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, staff members of the Chaghache' Day Care Center did this day report of their request to attend the Annual National State & Tribal Child Care Conference in Washington, D.C. from August 7 − 10, 2006; and

WHEREAS, they request that the tribe pay seven air fares and this amount to be reimbursed via payroll deduction and through fund raisers.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves payment of the seven air fares with reimbursement to the Tribe via payroll deduction.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 13, 2006</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
