



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Requesting WMA Housing Authority to Provide Priority Rental Housing to Jane Moody)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Jane Moody, an elder member of the Tribe who faces a physical disability, this day requested assistance from the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Moody requires rental housing and has not received timely assistance from the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority ("WMAHA"); and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that given Ms. Moody's physical and status as an elder, the WMAHA should give priority assistance to Ms. Moody for rental housing, and that such assistance is in the best interests of Ms. Moody and the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the WMAHA is hereby requested to provide priority rental housing to Jane Moody, because of her status as an elder member of the Tribe and her physical handicap.

The foregoing resolution was on September 13, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
