



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Approving increased Executive Travel Rates for Chairman, Vice Chairwoman, Tribal Council, Tribal Council Secretary and Tribal Treasurer)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, members of the Tribal Council this day discussed travel; and

**WHEREAS**, due to increasing travel costs, the Tribal Council agrees to implement higher travel rates; and

**WHEREAS**, they further propose that only the Chairman, the Vice Chairwoman, Tribal Council Members, Tribal Council Secretary and the Tribal Treasurer be allowed executive travel rates as follows:

<u><b>ONE DAY TRIP</b></u>	<u><b>OVERNIGHT TRIP</b></u>
\$200.00	\$400.00

**WHEREAS**, Tribal employees, including Chairman and Vice Chairwoman's staff, are to utilize the existing TR-100 Travel Reports at established current rates.

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council concurs that the revised executive travel rates is in the best interests of the Tribe.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. Executive travel rates as noted above will apply only to the Chairman, Vice Chairwoman, Tribal Council Members, Tribal Council Secretary and the Tribal Treasurer.
2. Tribal employees, including Chairman and Vice Chairwoman's staff, are to utilize the existing TR-100 Travel Reports at established current rates.

The foregoing resolution was on October 25, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ONE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
