



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Authorizing the burial of Jones Adley at the Fort Apache Cemetery)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, Jones Adley, a tribal member and resident of the community of Seven Mile, Arizona, recently passed away; and


**WHEREAS**, Mr. Adley was a descendent of an Apache scout; and


**WHEREAS**, the family of Jones Adley has requested that he be buried at the Fort Apache Cemetery; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fort Apache Cemetery is reserved as the final resting place for Apache scouts and veterans.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves burial of the late Jones Adley at the Fort Apache Cemetery.

The foregoing resolution was on October 31, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (d), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
