FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


(Approval of Land Board meeting minutes for May 25, 2006)



The foregoing resolution was on November 1, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Meeting opened in prayer by Pedro Johnson at 9:10 A.M.

1. Doris Chino – Came before the board on concerns about her late mother's cornfield that Ardella Alsenay had requested for at April Meeting. She brought the papers that her late mother Nora Foster had signed to relinquish her cornfield to her daughter and son. She was given application for the cornfield and to return them by the June board meeting.
2. Delmar Peaches– Requesting for land site in Hondah. Request approved.
3. Jennifer Lavender – Requesting for Cornfield and a land site by the dam on river road. Justin stated that someone always complains when this land is requested for and maybe if she goes to see this person they will allow her to get the landsite. She was given another application.
4. White Mountain Apache Christian Church - Requesting for a different area and relinquishing the other landsite. The area requesting for is the land site near the community service building. McDaniel told the board this land site is available. Board approved the request.
5. Kelsey James - Requesting for land in Canyon Day. McDaniel had taken Mr. James out to look at land sites and he had chosen this particular one, which is available. Board approved the request.
6. Vern Velasquez – Requesting for his late mothers cornfield located in Kinishba. Raymus will check into this and Mr. Velasquez was given a farmland application.
7. Darlene Gatewood – Requesting for an additional portion to her landsite for farmland and horse pastures. Raymus is concerned about the neighbor, for at one time there was dispute so they left the area in between the land sites open. Board decided to go ahead and allow for her to have ½ of the land. Board approved.
8. Clifford Antonio – Requesting for landsite that his present house is on in Whiteriver. Need sister's approval or relinquishment paper, return with the signature. Board approved.
9. Lucinda Beatty – Inquiring on her farmland that was given to her by her father. Her father passed away in 2000 and since then it is still on hold, but has documents pertaining to the farmland. Raymus asked Ms. Beatty to flag out the area so that he will check it out. On hold.

10. Rochelle Westover Mettingly - Requesting for landsite in Hondah lot #7. Mc Daniel told the board that the landsite is available. Board approved.
11. Jacob Henry - Requesting for farm land which his father relinquished to him. Both relinquishment and application forms approved.
12. A memo from Land Board Committee to Mike Stover, I.H.S. for the Carrizo and Hondah Lagoon. Approved and signed.
13. Beverly Brown – Requesting for land in East Fork but found she has a landsite already, Mc Daniel will check into this. On Hold.
14. Arlene Massey – Requesting for survey to be done on her landsite in Hondah, also for her daughter Tiffany Kinney at same area.
