



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Approving burial of the late Chee Harold Joe, spouse of White Mountain Apache tribal member Beatrice Cromwell Joe)**

**WHEREAS,** Chee Harold Joe, a resident of the communities of Canyon Day and Whiteriver, Arizona recently passed away; and

**WHEREAS,** Mr. Joe was the husband of Beatrice Cromwell Joe, a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** Mr. Joe had lived with his wife and family on the lands of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for over fifty years, and has been an important and beloved member of the community; and

**WHEREAS,** Council Member Reno Johnson, on behalf of the Joe family, has requested that Mr. Joe be buried in Canyon Day and that burial assistance be approved ; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds that the assistance provided herein is consistent with the culture and Tradition of White Mountain Apache and in sympathy to Mrs. Joe.


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves burial assistance for the late Chee Harold Joe in the amount of \$650 (\$250 cash assistance and \$400 for the beef).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:


1. Burial of Chee Harold Joe in Canyon Day is hereby authorized.
2. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on 11/9/06 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (d), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).





