



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Reinstatement of Youth Group Home staff)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe, and appoint employees; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was informed that some staff members of the Youth Group Home were recently terminated; and

WHEREAS, the basis of the termination was allegedly due to lack of P.L. 93-638 funds; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Tribal Council that sufficient funds exist to continue to operate the Youth Group Home, including payroll; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of the changed funding, the basis for the termination of the Youth Group Home no longer exists; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that those employees terminated from their employment at the Youth Group Home should be reinstated to their former positions.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Director of Social Services is hereby directed to reinstate those Youth Group Home employees recently terminated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Director of Social Services is further directed to provide the Tribal Council a full report on the funding status of the Youth Group Home at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Tribal Council, together with the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and that the Youth Group Home shall not be closed until such report has been provided and the Tribal Council has had an opportunity to fully consider the report.

The foregoing resolution was on January 11, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
