



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Authorizing Emergency Assistance for Ora Henry, Eleanor Banashley, Michael Patterson and Amending Resolution 12-2006-423 for such purpose)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, District I Council Member Arnold Beach, Sr., has this day made a request for emergency assistance for Ora Henry, Eleanor Banashley, Michael Patterson and that such assistance be paid out of the public relations line item of this budget; and

**WHEREAS**, for the purposes described herein, Council Member Beach requests that Resolution No. 12-2006-423 be amended in order to allow the payments required; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Henry and Ms. Banashley need \$50.00 each in transportation monies in order that they may attend a graduation ceremony for youth from their community, which is occurring on Saturday, March 24, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Patterson, who is an independent but handicapped individual, requires \$20.00 in assistance so that he can have his phone turned on and the phone is vital given his physical condition; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that the emergency assistance described herein to be in the best interest of the individuals and the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, given the urgency of the individuals requests, the Tribal Council further finds that an emergency expenditure needs to be considered and made outside of its regularly scheduled meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council further finds that: (1) this Resolution may be voted upon by signature of a member of the Tribal Council where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (2) the Tribal Council Secretary should attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (3) no signature would mean that the respective Tribal Council member is against this Resolution, (4) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:


1. The emergency assistance described herein is hereby authorized.
2. Resolution No. 12-2006-423 is hereby amended for the limited purposes described herein.


**Resolution No. 03-2006-107**

3. The Controller is hereby directed to remit payment in the amount of \$20.00 to Mr. Patterson, and \$50.00 each to Ms. Henry and Ms. Banashley, and said payment shall be made from the Public Relations line item of the budget for District I Council Member Beach.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that given the urgency of the request of Mr. Beach, this Resolution may be voted upon as follows: (a) by signature of a member of the Tribal Council, including the Chairman of the Tribal Council and the Vice-Chairwoman of the Tribal Council, where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (b) the Tribal Council Secretary should attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (c) no signature would mean that the respective Tribal Council member is against this Resolution, (d) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.


The foregoing resolution was on March 22, 2007, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
