

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving \$2,500 Expenditure to Assist Nephi Craig to Participate in Two International Culinary Events)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Nephi Craig did this day present a request to the Tribal Council for financial assistance; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Craig, a chef who formed the Native American Culinary Association, seeks to participate in two international culinary events in Sao Paulo, Brazil, and London, England; and
- WHEREAS, funds for such request exist in the Tribal Contributions Account; and
- WHEREAS, after discussion, the Tribal Council determined that an expenditure of \$2,500 was reasonable, given the costs involved; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Mr. Craig will represent the Tribe as an ambassador of not just its cuisine, but its culture, and therefore his participation in the two events are in the best interest of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

- 1. Nephi Craig's request for financial assistance is hereby approved.
- 2. The Treasurer is hereby directed to expend \$2,500 for purposes of providing financial assistance to Mr. Craig as described herein.
- 3. The Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairwoman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>March 7, 2007</u> adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Sections 1 (a), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe
